7 Steps To A Happier Pet

The Humane Society of the United States in its constant battle to end animal neglect, cruelty and abuse, encourages all of us to take the following actions in support of animals:

- 1) Make sure your pet wears an ID tag to enable him to be returned to you if lost.
- 2) To prevent animal behavioral problems, make sure you enroll your friends in behavioral training classes.
- 3) Animal behavioral problems may be health related. Make sure your friend has a complete medical exam by a veterinarian at least once a year.
- 4) Prepare for disasters. Make sure you have a plan for your friend in the event of a hurricane, tornado, fire or flood.
- 5) Plan for your friend's future in case something happens to you and visit www.humanesociety.org/petwills for more information.
- 6) Learn how to avoid dog bites and how to prevent your friend from biting, by going to www.NoDogBites.org
- 7) Have a heart, be smart and make sure your friend is spayed or neutered.

A Special Promotion from AWAS is the PET ID TAG RESCUE PROGRAM. This program allows for instant lost pet alerts to shelters and 24-hour customer support. Each tag has a serial number that has your pets' medical information as well as the profile. This information is linked to the monitoring system.

If your pet is lost, an alert will go out from Idpet.com to alert all shelters within 50 miles of where your pet was last located. An e-mail will be sent to the owner listing all of the shelters that received your lost pet bulletin so you won't have to wait for the shelters to contact you.

If anyone finds your pets, they can call the toll free number listed on the tag to retrieve any contact information. Contact us and we will send you a tag for your friend.

SAFETY TIPS FOR OUR FRIENDS:

Remember to keep your friend indoors during the "dog days of summer". If the temperature gets too hot, bring them in out of the heat.

Have plenty of fresh water available for your friends at all times...

It's the season for cookouts and picnics... avoid feeding your friends junk foods as well as bones of all types. Did you know that many plant leaves and flowers may be toxic to your pets. Keep this in mind this summer.

“Say Hello“...

Start by sitting on a chair, while holding a treat, put your hand between your knees and encourage your friend to get it. As soon as your friend's chin touches your leg, say “SAY HELLO”!. Then say “RELEASE” or “OK” and give him the treat after he lifts his head.

TIP:

Only give your dog the treat after you have released him. Increase the time his chin is touching your leg, so eventually your dog will keep it there while you pet him. Then release him and reward him. Your dog will soon charm your our friends with this trick!
